MEGA MEDICAL CAMP AT RAMPACHODAVARAM - 21ST DEC 2025

On 21st December 2025, NTR Memorial Trust organised a Free Mega Medical Camp at Rampachodavaram in Alluri Sitarama Raju District, reaffirming its commitment to delivering structured, accessible, and community-focused healthcare services to remote and tribal regions.

The camp was visited by Smt. Nara Bhuvaneshwari Garu, Managing Trustee, who reviewed the medical services being provided and interacted warmly with members of the local tribal community. During her visit, she administered polio drops to children as part of preventive healthcare initiatives and engaged with families to better understand their medical concerns and healthcare needs.



A dedicated team of qualified doctors and healthcare professionals provided comprehensive medical consultations and essential diagnostic screenings. Free medicines were distributed to patients based on medical prescriptions, ensuring immediate treatment and continuity of care. Additionally, spectacles were provided at no cost to individuals identified with vision impairments, significantly improving their quality of life and daily functioning. The camp was visited by the NTR Memorial Trust Managing Trustee, Smt. Nara Bhuvaneshwari Garu, who reviewed the services.

CARING BEYOND TRANSFUSIONS : NTR MEMORIAL TRUST'S COMMITMENT TO THALASSEMIA WARRIORS

Thalassaemia is a Genetic Blood Disorder that affects the body's ability to produce hemoglobin, leading to life-threatening anemia. Children diagnosed with Thalassaemia Major often require lifelong blood transfusions, iron chelation therapy, and regular medical supervision. The treatment is expensive and emotionally draining, especially for families from disadvantaged backgrounds.

NTR Memorial Trust has stepped forward as a lifeline for hundreds of Thalassaemia affected families, ensuring that no child is denied care due to financial constraints.

What NTR Memorial Trust Provides ??

1. Free Blood Transfusions

NTR Memorial Trust operates advanced blood centres that consistently supply safe, high-quality blood units free of cost. These transfusions are critical for the survival of children with Thalassaemia, many of whom require blood every few weeks to maintain basic health and organ function.

2. Essential Medication and Ongoing Treatment

Thalassaemia management involves more than just transfusions. To address iron overload from repeated transfusions, iron chelation therapy is essential. NTR Memorial Trust provides these expensive medications and follow-up tests free of charge, ensuring children receive comprehensive care.

3. Family-Centered Support

The Trust's approach is holistic—it not only offers medical care but also educates families, conducts counseling sessions, and builds awareness on prevention and early diagnosis. By empowering care givers, the Trust strengthens the long-term support system for each child.

Together, We Can Save Lives

The fight against Thalassaemia is ongoing—but through timely interventions, medical support, and community participation, NTR Memorial Trust is helping rewrite the story for many young lives across Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States.

Empowering Women for Self-Reliance: Skill Development Initiatives

As part of its mission to uplift communities through sustainable development, NTR Memorial Trust has initiated women empowerment programs in Kuppam, aimed at fostering economic independence and self-reliance among women.

Currently, over 515+ women are undergoing skill training in various livelihood generating trades. The Trust offers hands-on courses in Stitching, making of Jute bags, and Silk Thread Bangle crafting, enabling women to acquire practical skills that can lead to self-employment and income generation.

These programs are designed not only to provide vocational training but also to build confidence & leadership in participants, ensuring long-term empowerment.

By creating access to such skill-based opportunities, NTR Memorial Trust continues to strengthen its commitment to inclusive growth and gender equality.

The initiative has been well-received by the local community, with many women expressing enthusiasm for turning their skills into small businesses and cooperatives in the future.





NTR SUJALA: A LIFELINE OF SAFE DRINKING WATER FOR COMMUNITIES IN NEED

Access to safe drinking water continues to be a pressing concern in many underserved communities. In response to this critical need, NTR Memorial Trust initiated NTR Sujala – Safe Drinking Water Programme, a community-centric intervention aimed at providing dependable access to clean and potable water for vulnerable populations.



More than a water distribution initiative, NTR Sujala serves as an essential support system for families facing acute water scarcity and contamination risks. Anchored in a strong commitment to public health and human dignity, the programme addresses the gap between limited availability and daily necessity by ensuring a consistent supply of purified drinking water to high-need areas.

During the intensified outreach phase in **November and December 2025**, the programme delivered **514 water tankers**, comprising **200 tankers in November and 314 in December**, each with a capacity of **5,000 litres**. This effort enabled an average distribution of **20 litres** per family per day, directly benefiting over **4,284 families** across multiple underserved locations. For many households, this support extended beyond water access contributing to improved health, stability, and a renewed sense of security.

The effectiveness of NTR Sujala is driven by systematic planning, targeted allocation based on ground-level needs, and disciplined implementation. By prioritising communities most in need, the programme reinforces its broader objective of strengthening community well-being and protecting lives.

Amid escalating climate challenges and mounting pressure on water resources, NTR Sujala stands as an example of a sustainable humanitarian intervention guided by compassion, operational rigour, and a long-term vision for water security.

Every drop holds value, and through NTR Sujala, each drop is delivered with intention and impact.

As part of its unwavering commitment to community well-being, NTR Memorial Trust continues to organize Monthly Health Check-up Camps across Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. These camps are a vital initiative aimed at making quality healthcare services accessible to underserved communities, regardless of economic background.

Each health camp offers comprehensive medical services, including general health check-ups, screenings for common illnesses, blood pressure and sugar level monitoring, and consultations with qualified doctors. Where needed, free medications are also provided.



By proactively addressing health issues and raising awareness about preventive care, NTR Memorial Trust is not only treating ailments but also empowering individuals to take charge of their health. The camps are well-received by the public and have seen growing participation month after month.

FREE HEALTH SCREENINGS

These camps provide a wide range of medical screenings and consultations to underserved communities at no cost. Attendees benefit from comprehensive evaluations in areas such as Diabetology, Cardiology, Pulmonology, Ophthalmology, Gynaecology, General Medicine, Dermatology, ENT (ear, nose, & throat), Orthopaedics, and more.

Additionally, routine health checks including blood pressure monitoring and assessments of height, weight, and BMI are conducted.



A dedicated team of experienced doctors and specialists oversee these services, ensuring high standards of care. These camps not only help identify potential health issues at an early stage but also educate individuals on managing their well-being, empowering them to make informed decisions about their health.

NTR SANJEEVANI AROGYA KENDRAM AND AROGYA RATHAM

NTR Sanjeevani Arogya Kendram and NTR Arogya Rathams are flagship healthcare initiatives of NTR Memorial Trust, aimed at delivering quality medical services to underserved and remote communities across Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. These initiatives operate through fixed healthcare clinics located at Kuppam, Salur, Hindupur, Rajahmundry, Duggirala, Tadepalli, and Mangalagiri, along with mobile medical clinics that extend essential healthcare services to interior and hard-to-reach areas, ensuring accessible, affordable, and timely medical care for all.

RURAL HEALTH CLINIC: NTR SANJEEVANI FREE CLINICS

In an effort to address the healthcare needs of rural communities, NTR Memorial Trust has established rural health clinics in underserved areas. These clinics offer comprehensive primary healthcare services, including specialized care for chronic diseases, aiming to bridge the gap between rural communities and quality healthcare services.

MOBILE MEDICAL UNITS

NTR Sanjeevani Free Clinic operates Mobile Medical Units equipped with advanced facilities, serving remote areas. A dedicated team of highly skilled Doctors and Nurses offers comprehensive medical check-ups, treatment, and essential medication free of charge to patients. Their mission is to ensure that individuals in the most underserved communities receive the healthcare they rightfully deserve.

FREE EDUCATION TO ORPHAN / UNDER PRIVILEGED CHILDREN

Education is a powerful force that drives transformation. Beyond academic learning, it nurtures character, builds self-belief, and opens doors to new opportunities. For children facing social and economic hardships, education becomes a source of hope, dignity, and the promise of a brighter future. By enabling access to learning, this initiative not only transforms individual lives but also strengthens the communities they are part of.

Mission

The mission is rooted in the conviction that every child—regardless of background or circumstance—deserves access to quality education. We are committed to providing a safe, inclusive, and nurturing learning environment where orphaned and underprivileged children can thrive academically, emotionally, and socially.

Through consistent educational support, the programme aims to equip children with knowledge, values, and essential life skills, empowering them to lead independent, purposeful, and fulfilling lives.

At Challapalli School, free education along with residential facilities is provided to 388 underprivileged children each year. Over the years, thousands of orphaned and economically disadvantaged students have benefitted from free education and accommodation, enabling them to pursue their studies without financial constraints.

The true impact of this initiative is reflected in the lives of its students. Children who once faced uncertainty and limited access to education are now demonstrating academic excellence, confidence, and ambition. Many have identified their strengths, pursued higher education, and set their sights on professional careers—standing as inspiring examples of how education can truly transform lives.
