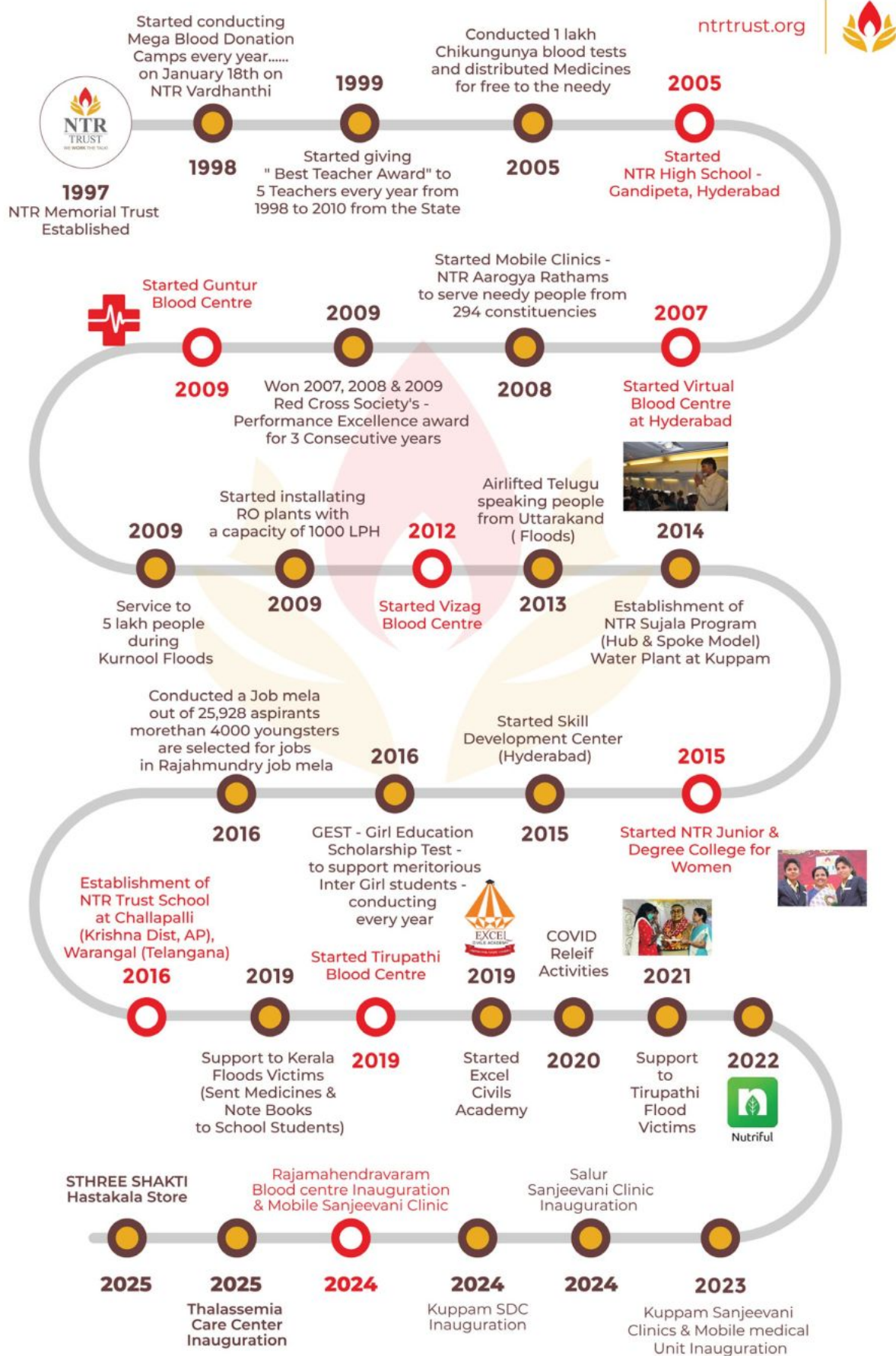

Early Years (1997–2005)

The Trust began by focusing on education and healthcare initiatives in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Establishment of Blood Centres and healthcare camps marked its early impact in community health.

Launch of Educational scholarships for meritorious underprivileged students.

Expansion Phase (2005–2015)

The Trust broadened its scope to include NTR Schools, providing CBSE-affiliated education with emphasis on holistic development.

Initiatives like the NTR Sujala Pathakam were introduced to ensure safe drinking water in rural communities.

Active participation in disaster relief and rehabilitation during natural calamities such as floods and cyclones further strengthened its role as a humanitarian organization.

Recent Years (2015–Present)

Consolidated its work in four core domains:

Education

High-quality schooling, scholarships and youth leadership development as well as Junior and Degree colleges for women.

Healthcare

Blood Centres, health camps and affordable medical support.

Disaster Relief

Rapid response to floods, pandemics and other emergencies.

Oxygen Generation Plant

Demonstrates the commitment to improving the lives of rural communities and those in need.

Empowerment

Programs to build skills, Entrepreneurship and Livelihoods for women and youth.

During COVID-19, the Trust actively supported communities with food, medicine and relief kits.

Today, it is widely recognized for integrity, scale and community-driven impact across Telugu states and beyond.



Main Events

FY 2025

In April 2024 and again on August 2024, Smt. Nara Bhuvaneshwari Garu, Managing Trustee of NTR Memorial Trust, inaugurated newly donated ambulances that strengthened the Trust's medical services. The first ambulance was generously contributed by the Intas Foundation, followed by another ambulance donated by Promea Therapeutics to support healthcare and emergency services. Speaking on the occasion, Smt. Nara Bhuvaneshwari Garu highlighted that the Trust's wide range of service initiatives is made possible through the continued

support of donors and well-wishers, and reaffirmed the Trust's commitment to expanding such humanitarian and medical programs in the future through NTR Memorial Trust.

On July 27 2024, Smt. Nara Bhuvaneshwari Garu inaugurated of the Skill Development Centre in Kuppam, marking a significant step toward women's empowerment and livelihood support. During the event, she distributed sewing machines to women beneficiaries and provided push carts to small vendors.

With the objective of enabling women to achieve financial independence, the NTR Memorial Trust has initiated free sewing machine training as part of its skill development efforts, translating commitment into meaningful action on the ground.

NTR Trust donated ₹1 crore in August 2024 to support the relaunch of Anna Canteens in Andhra Pradesh. These canteens, initiated to provide subsidised meals at ₹5 to labourers and the poor, are being revived to honour the vision of late Padma Shr. Dr. N.T. Rama Rao

Financial Performance






The financial trajectory of the NTR Trust over the period under review reflects phases of contraction and consolidation. The initial years witnessed a decline in both income and expenditure, culminating in a trough before the Trust moved into a phase of recovery. This turnaround was characterised by a steady improvement in income levels, accompanied by a calibrated increase in expenditure. In the most recent years, a marginal softening in both income and spending is evident, suggesting a sharper focus on efficiency and prudent financial planning. Across the period, the surplus has remained largely consistent, with only limited fluctuations, underscoring the Trust's emphasis on maintaining a balanced and sustainable financial position.

NTR Memorial Trust Blood Centre is the first in the Country to conceptualize the idea of Blood Banking through 24/7 call center.

NTR Memorial Trust, through its Blood Centres, provides safe blood and its components.

The primary goals are

- Explore and identify innovative means and ways of improving functioning of Blood Centres. Enhance the number of Blood Storage Centres in AP & Telangana.
- Increase in providing free blood units and free medicines to Thalassemia Patients.

Since 2008, NTR Memorial Trust Blood Centres have been operating across multiple locations in close collaboration with voluntary donors, IT and pharma companies, educational institutions and hospitals. They are accredited by NABH and certified under ISO 9001:2015, equipped with modern, automated technology and state-of-the-art facilities for blood donation, component preparation, storage and distribution. Operating round the clock, 365 days a year, the Centres ensure the timely availability of safe and quality blood to those in need.

The mission of the Blood Centres is to enable availability of safe blood to the needy and free blood units to Thalassemia patients.

NTR Memorial Trust Blood Centres ensure the availability of safe blood and a wide range of blood components, including Whole Blood, PRBC, RDPs, FFPs, Cryoprecipitate, SDP and Convalescent Plasma.

To further enhance accessibility, the Trust has introduced a unique doorstep delivery system: patient samples are collected from hospitals, processed at our blood centres and the required blood or blood components are delivered back to the hospitals in a timely manner.

NTR Blood Centres are in four locations – Hyderabad, Vishakapatnam, Tirupati and the newly opened one at Rajamahendravaram.

The Blood Centres ensure timely availability of safe blood, promote voluntary blood donation and provide free blood to Thalassemia, Sickle Cell Anemia and Hemophilia patients & needy patients from below the poverty line.

The centres also network with hospitals, NGO's, Educational Institutions, NSS, Public & Private Institutions.

NTR Memorial Trust initially started a virtual Blood Centre, a first of its kind, to promote voluntary blood donations in India. In association with Indian Red Cross Society, NTR Memorial Trust conducted many voluntary blood donation drives to help the poor and needy patients. With ever increasing demand for Blood and its various components, NTR Memorial Trust has started its first Blood Centre in Hyderabad in the year 2008 which was the first one to be recognized as RBTC (Regional Blood Transfusion Center).

It is also the first NGO run standalone Blood bank in South India with NABH accreditation/ISO 9001:2015 certified having one of South India's most advanced testing facilities with Nucelic Acid Testing (NAT) to detect infections that regular serological tests might fail to detect.

It also won Red Cross Society's Award for performance excellence for three consecutive years.

NTR Memorial Trust provides free, primary healthcare services across both Telugu-speaking states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. To ensure consistency and quality, we have established well-defined Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for conducting medical camps. These camps are designed to create health awareness, deliver proper medical consultations, facilitate referrals to hospitals when needed and distribute free medicines and accessories to underserved communities.

Our medical camps primarily focus on screening and consultation for chronic and lifestyle-related diseases such as cancer, diabetes, arthritis, kidney ailments, asthma and hypertension. Professionally qualified doctors and nurses deliver essential primary care, while awareness programs are regularly conducted in rural and hard-to-reach areas on common health concerns like anemia, dengue and diarrhea.

Thalassemia Care Centre

Thalassemia is a major inherited blood disorder that affects millions globally. It is marked by abnormally low hemoglobin levels in red blood cells, which in turn causes multiple health complications. Management of Thalassemia typically involves regular blood transfusions, strict monitoring and control of iron levels and in severe cases, bone marrow transplantation. With timely medical guidance and consistent treatment, individuals living with Thalassemia can significantly improve their quality of life.

In India, approximately 1 in every 10,000 births is affected by Thalassemia Major. Hyderabad alone is estimated to have around 3,500 patients living with this condition.

NTR Thalassemia Care Centre is committed to issue safe and quality blood to Thalassemia children, at no cost. It has initiated the 'Blood Shield Program' to provide safe blood and medicines to the thalassaemic children who are economically compromised. We have more than 80 Thalassemia cases visiting us on a regular basis for blood transfusion. We have established 25 bedded Thalassemia Care Centre, which would identify and register donors and cluster them by blood group and donate to the same thalassemia child, to avoid reactions and further complications.

NTR Sujala – Safe Drinking Water

Access to safe and reliable drinking water continues to be one of India's most pressing public health challenges. More than 1.2 billion people still lack clean drinking water, with 80% of illnesses linked to waterborne pathogens. Tragically, 5 million people, mostly children, die each year from diarrhoea caused by contaminated water and nearly 50% of hospitalizations are a result of waterborne diseases.

Recognizing this urgent need, NTR Memorial Trust launched the Safe Drinking Water Project at Kuppam, adopting a cluster approach that has proven highly successful. A Mother Plant, equipped with state-of-the-art purification technology, was set up with a capacity of 10,000 liters per hour. This plant serves as a hub, supplying water to 20 dispensation

units across 20 villages/wards, reaching nearly 10,000 households. Purified drinking water is made affordable and accessible at just Rs. 2 for 20 liters, offering immense relief to communities.

The project is backed by digital technology, enabling real-time monitoring of water quality, production, distribution, tank levels, maintenance schedules and user utilization. Cashless transactions ensure transparency and accountability.

Building on this success, the Trust has established NTR Sujala plants in CRDA regions of Andhra Pradesh (Harishchandrapuram and Venkatapalem). Today, the initiative provides safe drinking water to over 100 villages, directly benefiting more than 50,000 people across Andhra Pradesh.

With a strong emphasis on rural communities, the Trust conducts Entrepreneurship Development Programs (EDPs) and Skill Development Programs (SDPs) that open pathways for sustainable income generation. These initiatives go beyond technical and vocational training by also nurturing essential life skills such as critical thinking, problem-solving and effective work habits. By empowering young people to become job-ready and self-reliant, the Trust aims to enhance their economic, social and physical well-being, enabling them to emerge as change-makers within their families and communities.

Over the years, the Trust has become a catalyst for youth empowerment in united Andhra Pradesh. More than 10,000 young people have been equipped with entrepreneurial acumen, inventory management techniques and marketing expertise, while an additional 5,000 youth from 250 villages have gained valuable vocational skills. To ease their transition into the workforce, the Trust has also extended Rs. 4 crore in financial support to unemployed youth.

In today's world, where national and global markets evolve at lightning speed, a clear gap often exists between traditional skills and the competencies demanded by emerging opportunities. Recognizing this challenge, the Trust has taken deliberate steps to prepare the next generation for a dynamic marketplace.

With this vision, Skill Development Centres were established in Hyderabad, Vinukonda and Tada,

creating hubs of learning and innovation. Through these centres and focused Entrepreneurship Development Programs, the Trust has already empowered over 6,700 young aspirants, helping them transform potential into progress. Some of the activities undertaken are tailoring, jute bag making, chikankari work and silk thread bangle making work.

The Skill Development Centre at Kuppam, commissioned in July 2024, has been established as a community-focused hub for vocational learning and livelihood enhancement. The centre offers free skill-based courses in areas such as tailoring, silk thread bangle making and jute bag making, enabling participants to acquire practical, income-generating capabilities. By focusing on locally relevant crafts and hands-on training, the center supports skill development, self-reliance and improved livelihood opportunities for individuals from the surrounding communities.

NTR Trust organised a free DSE training programme in Kuppam. Of the participants who completed the course, 17 successfully cleared the DSE exam—thus opening up meaningful career opportunities for them.

What began as a response to a skills gap is steadily growing into a movement, shaping confident, capable youth who are ready to lead in a competitive world.

Relief Operation - Phailin Cyclone

In 2013, incessant rains and flooding wreaked havoc across several districts of Andhra Pradesh, including Guntur, Prakasam and Krishna, causing widespread destruction and severe distress. The calamity claimed lives, destroyed property and left thousands of families homeless and vulnerable.

Responding swiftly, NTR Memorial Trust mobilized its relief teams to some of the worst-affected regions. To address the urgent healthcare needs of survivors, 25 medical camps were organized, through which more than 10,000 patients received medical consultations and essential medicines free of cost.

Alongside healthcare, the Trust prioritized immediate survival needs by distributing safe drinking water, buttermilk and cooked food, ensuring that the victims had access to basic nutrition and clean water in the aftermath of the disaster.

This comprehensive relief response not only alleviated immediate suffering but also reinforced the Trust's mission of standing by communities during their most challenging times with care, compassion and action.

Opinion
